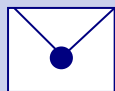

Walking Bus Launches



A new walking bus is making its way around Ynysddu to help local children get to the local primary school safely. The 'Walking Bus' sees pupils travel to and from school in supervised groups.

The new walking bus at Ynysddu Primary School was launched during National Walk to School Week (17 - 21 May), to encourage more school pupils to walk, rather than be driven to school.

A green cone scheme is also running at the school, and the cones are placed outside the school at the start and end of the school day to encourage more people to walk to school or park away from the entrance.

Warrants executed

During a one-day operation at the end of June, 24 arrests were made for a variety of offences after search warrants were conducted on properties across the Caerphilly County Borough.

On the day arrests were made for offences including non-payment of fines, possession of drugs, theft and criminal damage. In Risca, a man was arrested and charged with burglary. £4500 and a jet ski were also seized from properties across the county borough under the Proceeds of Crime Act.

CURRENT PRIORITIES FOR YNYSDDU

REMINDER TO LOCK DOORS

Residents in Risca are being reminded to close and lock their doors and windows following a small number of burglaries in the area.

Officers are offering the following advice to residents:

- Remember to close and secure all doors and windows at night and when you go out
- Keep your front and back doors locked, even when you are at home during the day
- If you have locked your door, take the keys out of the lock and put them somewhere safe and out of reach from doors or windows
- Don't leave expensive property in sight, close to a window
- Keep your car keys safe and out of sight
- Close all curtains when you have the lights on at night
- Shut and lock garden gates
