### Parking Near Schools



We'd like to remind parents of the need to park safely and legally when taking and picking up their children from local schools. A number of schools are concerned that vehicles are causing an obstruction and a danger to pupils and pedestrians.

Drivers are committing offences when they park on yellow zig zag school entrance warnings, double yellow lines and roundabouts as well as on pavements and in resident permit bays. Please have consideration for residents living near schools and don't obstruct driveways or access to property. Anyone found parking illegally could receive a £30 fine.
