PACT Priority updates

Speeding Vehicles

Over the month of December the ward team has had four days dedicated to policing the issue of speeding vehicles. In these action days 21 vehicles were found to be in excess of the road speed limit and the drivers were warned and educated about the dangers of speeding. A further two drivers were prosecuted for driving offences and issued with fines of £60 and points on their driving licences.

Other matters

Following the most recent ward meetings the team have also been asked to look at the area around the Underwood shops in relation to any anti-social behaviour taking place and the misuse of off road bikes in the areas around and between Bishton and Goldcliff and these have been set as our current ward priorities.
