Thank you for your recent request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

- 1) The number of antisemitic offences recorded by your force each month from October 2021 to October 2024 inclusive.
- 2) The number of Islamophobic offences recorded by your force each month from October 2021 to October 2024 inclusive.
