Dear requester,

Thank you for your recent request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) places two duties on public authorities. Unless exemptions apply, the first duty at, **Section 1(1) (a)**, is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. The second duty at, **Section 1 (1) (b)**, is to disclose information that has been confirmed as being held.

The information that you are seeking is in relation to the following:

REQUEST

I'm looking for information on the reported number of stolen mobile phones from the following dates:

- Between 1st January 2023 to 31st December 2023.
- From 1st January 2024 to 31st December 2024.

Here are my following questions:

- How many mobile phones were reported stolen during the two time frames?
- Which areas had the most reports of the stolen mobile phones and how many in the two time frames?

RESPONSE

Please find below a table for theft of a mobile phone for 2023 and 2024. To provide this data we have searched under the crime category of Theft from a Person and All Other Theft then completed a keyword search of 'phone' and 'mobile phones' and filtered to Neighbourhood.
