Dear requester,

Thank you for your recent request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

**Section 1** of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) places two duties on public authorities. Unless exemptions apply, the first duty at, **Section 1(1) (a)**, is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. The second duty at, **Section 1 (1) (b)**, is to disclose information that has been confirmed as being held.

The information that you are seeking is in relation to the following:

Please can you provide the following information.

1. In 24/25 how many conditional cautions were issued by your police force for domestic abuse related offences. Can these be broken down and provided with men compared to women.
2. Can you provide the same details for the year 2023/24?
3. Who is your provider for domestic abuse conditional caution interventions?

#### 1 & 2

The below data is based on the recorded dates and shows all crimes where a domestic abuse tag was used and where the outcome was stated as conditional caution.

Please note that outcomes are completely dependent on what the officer has inputted onto the system, it is a manual process.

If they have not manually updated this, then the information would not have been updated and won't be correct.

The below data is showing the number of offenders that were linked to the number of crimes.
