Thank you for your recent request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) places two duties on public authorities. Unless exemptions apply, the first duty at, **Section 1(1) (a)**, is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. The second duty at, **Section 1 (1) (b)**, is to disclose information that has been confirmed as being held.

Under the freedom of information act 2000, I request the following information on behalf of Global media/LBC:

1. The total number of hate crime offences recorded by your force for April, May, June, July, August, September and October 2025.
2. The number of hate crime offences classed under the strand of 'race or ethnicity' by your force for April, May, June, July, August, September and October 2025.
3. The number of hate crime offences classed under the strand of 'religion' by your force for April, May, June, July, August, September and October 2025.

RESPONSE

The following data has been obtained using all hate crimes recorded between the 1st April 2025 and the 31st October 2025 under the following five hate strands: racial, religious, disability, homophobic, and transphobic. This data is accurate as of the 18th November 2025.
